1. Your hotel: Yesterday Hotel, Address: no 8 Economu Cezarescu Street, 6th district, Bucharest, Romania, <http://hotel.yesterday.ro>.

Generally you check-in with dinner on 15 October and check-out with breakfast on 20 October. Please, check the hotel's web-site for check-in/out hours and other rules!


2. EYLDS Venue: Salon Rouge of Yesterday Hotel. How do you reach the hotel from airport?

From airport you take Express bus 783 to Unirii Square (Piata Unirii). It is the last station.

The departure from the Airport is at the Arrivals Terminal bus stop, outside the doors, where the ticket/card booth is also located. Tickets: You can only buy a return journey card at the cost of 7 lei/two journeys. Note that tickets cannot be purchased from the driver!

From Unirii Square you take the Metro line M1 and you will stop at 'Grozavesti' station. The a metro fare is 2 lei.

Yesterday Hotel is near the metro station (as in the following map).



Very important! In case you decide to take a taxi from airport to hotel, we strongly advice you not to use individual taxi, not respond to drivers who come to you asking if you want a taxi for town. Ignore all these offers!!! You can use the taxi call machine (free) and choose the taxi company (The cheapest taxi rate is 1,39lei/km).

Note that only the costs for the public transportation (Express bus and metro/ underground ticket not taxi) will be reimbursed for the return trip airport- hotel-airport!

4. Where do you change money?

You have to change in the airport in order to buy tickets for Express 783. In town, you can change in banks, hotels, exchange offices.

5. Hotel surroundings?

- the hotel is placed near the student campus Grozavesti, the largest in Bucharest
- from Grozavesti metro station you can take route M1 to Izvor station (2 stations distance) and reach the Parliament Palace (People's House)
- for the Old City Center you can also take the metro/underground to Piata Unirii station (M1) and then change to M2 to Universitate station; there are a lot of restaurants and bars in the old city center; you can also visit some historical places, but many of them are still in process of restoration.

6. Optional networking & cultural activities in workshop evenings

On the first workshop day (16 October) we will present some options concerning the free time that we have after the workshop activities during the day. We will make together the decisions regarding the networking/ cultural activities.

Unfortunately, Youth in Action programme does not support visiting expenses, but we have negotiated special prices for a youth group. We will decide together on the first day if we will spend or not additional sums in order to have a pleasant stay in Bucharest!
